Blue-White (www.blue-white.com) equipped its Pro-series-M MD-3 Hybrid Diaphragm Chemical Metering Pump with sonic-welded manifolds for added durability and protection from chemical leaks. The pump provides precision chemical metering for treating municipal water and wastewater and is NSF 61, CE, ETL, and NEMA 4X certified.

Endress+Hauser (www.us.endress.com) released Proline 300/500, a line of industry-optimized smart Coriolis mass and electromagnetic flow instruments. The Proline Promass Coriolis mass flowmeters are available in 11 model sizes for measuring flows up

to 100,000 tons/day, and the Proline Promag flowmeters are available in three model sizes for volume flows up to 634 mgd.

GF Piping Systems (www.gfps.com) expanded its automation product line with two new Level Transmitters that incorporate advanced radar sensing technology designed for high-accuracy tank level measurement in a wide range of chemical processing and water treatment applications. The technology employs electromagnetic waves that fumes or gases don't affect.

Great Water Tech (greatwatertech.com) released the German-engineered Folmar Pipe Protection product for addressing lead pipe remediation. The product, which can be injected at any point of a water system, including at a point-of-entry into a specific building, is a proprietary silicate-based formulation that creates a thin glass layer on a pipe wall interior to separate metal from water, stopping corrosion and

scale formation and preventing leaching of lead, copper, and other metals into drinking water carried by corroded pipes.

Microvi (www.microvi.com) partnered with Sunny Slope (Calif.) Water Co. to launch an advanced nitrate removal technology, Denitrovi, for groundwater sources to provide more than 200 mil gal/yr of potable water for Sunny Slope's 30,000 households. The environmentally sustainable technology offers significant cost savings and largely eliminates the secondary waste stream typical of conventional technologies.

Tank Connection (www.tankconnection.com) expanded its Galesburg, Kan., facility to support fabrication of the company's new AQUA AGT 2020 glass coating formulation for steel tanks. The company previously released the new line of glass/porcelain enamel-fused-to-steel tank panels.
